**Earthquake in Mexico:**

On Tuesday afternoon, a major earthquake occurred about 70 miles outside of Mexico City. There has been considerable damage in the capital city, with more than 40 buildings collapsed. The death toll is more than 200 and is expected to rise to possibly as many as 1,000. People are still being rescued from collapsed buildings. The president of Mexico

declared a state of emergency in the city and requested that people stay off the streets. The downtown area sustained the most damage.

I have been in contact with Larry Roybal, our pastor in Mexico, and he has confirmed that no members were injured, but that some did sustain damage to their homes. One of the elders in Mexico City, Alfredo Lopez, and his wife, Mercedes, left a building in the downtown area just as the quake was occurring, and they watched as the building collapsed behind them. They were able to make it out of the city and back to their home safely, but it was a very close call.

The church hall, where services are scheduled for Trumpets, had no damage, but the electricity is out. The members are hoping to get their generator operational so they can have services on the Feast of Trumpets. Approximately 40 percent of Mexico City is currently without power.

My wife and I were scheduled to be in Mexico City for Trumpets and the Sabbath that follows. But as a result of the earthquake and the difficulty with travel in the city, we sadly had to cancel our trip. We are still hopeful that services can be conducted with the two elders who live in Mexico City, but that will be decided once the issue with electricity has been resolved.

Please pray for everyone who has been affected by this devastating earthquake. There were many sad stories about the human tragedies on the news this morning. But there was one that just broke your heart. A primary school collapsed, and 32 people, most of them children, died. There are still 30 people missing—most of them also children—and presumed to be under the pile of rubble that was once a school.
