Interstate 70 Closure:

From Greg Sargent:

For those using Interstate 70 (Missouri side) coming to Sabbath services on June 9th, please be aware of the following:

JACKSON COUNTY– The Missouri Department of Transportation will have a **COMPLETE CLOSURE** of Interstate 70 in both directions between I-435 and I-470 beginning at 10 p.m. on Friday, June 8, until approximately 5 a.m. on Monday, June 11. This closure is for the demolition of the Pittman Road, Crysler Avenue, and Phelps Road bridges over I-70. This work will have major impacts to traffic. Plan ahead. Leave early. Motorists **MUST** follow the signed detour using I-470 and I-435, or find an alternate route. All work is weather permitting.
