BIBLE QUIZ – 2 Samuel, continued (Answers below)

- When the king of Ammon died, David sent some servants to extend sympathy to Hanun, the king's son. How were they received by the Ammonites? (*2 Samuel 10:4*)
 - They tortured them brutally, in retaliation for David's past dealings with Ammon, then released them.
 - They received them warmly, and signed a treaty strengthening their loyalty to David.
 - Hanun had them put up at the Hyatt, and put everything on his tab.
 - They thought the servants were spies, and intimidated them by shaving off half of their beards and mutilating their garments. Then they sent them away.
 - The Ammonites believed the servants of David planned to kill Hanun. They cut off the feet of the servants, then publicly hung them.
